Students' Feedback Report

Patel Science College, Taloda, is one of the reputed educational institution catering to the higher educational needs of the rural & tribal students of north Maharashtra. Situated at the foothills of the Satpuda mountain ranges, it has been imparting education to the most under privileged section of society. The college has been instrumental in bringing about this region. society in of the section of weaker empowerment With quality sustenance as its focus, the IQAC of the college has developed the feedback mechanism commencing with obtaining feedback from stakeholders through a structured rating based feedback form. The college draws for continuous improvement alumnae teachers, and from students, feedback and all round development of the students. For the current year, the analysis of stakeholders' feedback is presented as under:

Students Feedback Mechanism

The institution has established a system of collecting feedback from the students once in a year. The feedback is collected online from various students through a built in feedback form. Students will respond to the structured questionnaire on certain key elements related to syllabus and its transactions .Feedback is considered only if a minimum of 50-60 % students participate in the feedback session. Almost all questions are asked on five point Likert scale basis, 0 showing minimum and 4 showing maximum. Performance on any parameter and on overall level performance is evaluated as follows:

As the feedback is collected on five point Likert scale a generally accepted threshold ratio of 80% is expected on overall level, means on overall 13 parameters if average score comes to 80% of maximum score of 4 i.e. 3.2 in our case, it will assume that the college is successfully met students' expectation.

For deciding the urgency of interventions to be required to take following cut off ratios are used.

Major Observations and Recommendations of Students' Feedback:

Strengths:

- Teacher Support and Encouragement: Teachers are highly rated for encouraging
 participation in extracurricular activities (3.95), helping students identify and
 overcome weaknesses (3.8), and applying student-centric methods like experiential
 learning (3.85). These aspects are excellent and require maintenance.
- Communication: Teachers' ability to communicate effectively and explain concepts
 through examples and applications is also highly rated (3.71, 3.35), suggesting good
 communication skills.
- Course Structure and Preparation: There is a strong sense of preparedness and clarity in course expectations, with high ratings for preparing for classes (3.1) and informing students about competencies and outcomes (3.05).

Areas for Improvement:

Teaching Approach and Student Engagement: Several aspects related to teaching methods, such as the teaching approach (2.35) and engagement in learning opportunities (2.22), have lower scores and need attention. The institution is performing relatively well but could improve in how they foster more interactive, engaging learning experiences.

- Mentoring and Evaluation: Feedback on mentor follow-ups (1.63), evaluation fairness (2.18), and discussion of performance (2.14) indicate areas where more consistent attention is needed.
- ICT Tools and Resources: The use of ICT tools (1.8) during teaching is notably low, pointing to a significant gap in technological integration that needs urgent intervention.
- Opportunities for Growth: While the institution provides opportunities, the
 feedback suggests improvements are needed in offering more hands-on learning, such
 as internships and student exchange programs (1.58), and promoting emotional and
 social growth (1.58).

Overall Feedback:

Satisfactory to Very Good Performance: The institution is performing overall at a
"Very Good" level (average score of 2.78), but several areas are either good or fair,
indicating room for improvement. The overall threshold score is slightly below the
desired 80% target, suggesting a need for more focused efforts in key areas.
